**Adjustment of Fares**—Should any misunderstanding arise with conductors or agents as to the proper fare or ticket privileges, please pay fare requested, take receipt and communicate with General Passenger Agent, Pennsylvania Station, Philadelphia 4, Pa.  
**Children**—Under 5 years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age and over, full fare.  
**Parlor Cars**—All parlor car service on the Pennsylvania Railroad, both local and interline, is operated by the Pullman Company.  
**Responsibility**—The Pennsylvania Railroad is not responsible for errors in time tables, nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections, or for shortage of equipment. 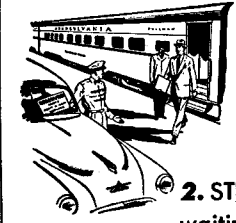
